This report contains the results from the **Crop Progress and Condition** weekly survey and data from the Southern Regional Climate Center. The survey is completed by county extension agents' visual observations and contact with producers in their county. Week Ending: September 27, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 3.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 27, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 15 percent short, 64 percent adequate, and 20 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 12 percent short, 66 percent adequate, and 20 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 49.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Lead Hill to 63.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Eudora. Highs ranged from 65.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Prescott to 78.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Portland. Moderate to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southeast part of the State with an average of 5.29 inches.
