Week Ending: October 11, 2020

Released: October 13, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, October 11, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 14 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 16 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 15 percent short, 62 percent adequate, and 20 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 42.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Gilbert to 55.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Winslow and Ashdown. Highs ranged from 70.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Newport to 80.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Eudora. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southeast part of the State with an average of 1.56 inches.
