This report contains the results from the **Crop Progress and Condition** weekly survey and data from the Southern Regional Climate Center. The survey is completed by county extension agents' visual observations and contact with producers in their county. ### Week Ending: October 25, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 4.9 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, October 25, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 15 percent short, 66 percent adequate, and 17 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 16 percent short, 67 percent adequate, and 15 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 47.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Cabot and Corning to 62.6 degrees Fahrenheit at De Queen and Portland. Highs ranged from 65.8 degrees Fahrenheit at Corning to 83.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Portland. Scarce precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the south central part of the State with an average of 0.95 inch.
