Week Ending: November 1, 2020

Released: November 2, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 2.2 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 1, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 7 percent short, 67 percent adequate, and 26 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 10 percent short, 65 percent adequate, and 23 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 34.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 46.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Rohwer. Highs ranged from 48.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 62.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Moderate to heavy precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the northwest part of the State with an average of 8.56 inches.
