Week Ending: November 15, 2020

Released: November 16, 2020

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.7 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 15, 2020**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 17 percent short, 73 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 14 percent short, 76 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 42.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 56.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Eudora. Highs ranged from 65.3 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 79.2 degrees Fahrenheit at Eudora. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the north central part of the State with an average of 0.75 inch.
