Week Ending: July 4, 2021

Released: July 6, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 6.3 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, July 4, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 7 percent very short, 44 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 32 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 64.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Mammoth Spring to 74.5 degrees Fahrenheit at Stuttgart. Highs ranged from 78.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 91.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Searcy. Light to moderate precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the west central part of the State with an average of 1.59 inches.
