This report contains the results from the **Crop Progress and Condition** weekly survey and data from the Southern Regional Climate Center. The survey is completed by county extension agents' visual observations and contact with producers in their county. Week Ending: September 19, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.8 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, September 19, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 19 percent very short, 39 percent short, 38 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 18 percent very short, 39 percent short, 40 percent adequate, and 3 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 62.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Evening Shade to 71.0 degrees Fahrenheit at West Memphis. Highs ranged from 83.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Magnolia and Rohwer to 90.9 degrees Fahrenheit at Morrilton. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the southeast part of the State with an average of 1.34 inches.
