**Week Ending: October 10, 2021**

**Released: October 12, 2021**

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, October 10, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 6 percent very short, 33 percent short, 49 percent adequate, and 12 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 10 percent very short, 33 percent short, 52 percent adequate, and 5 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 55.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Murfreesboro to 63.7 degrees Fahrenheit at Stuttgart. Highs ranged from 74.1 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 87.4 degrees Fahrenheit at Nashville. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the northwest part of the State with an average of 0.90 inch.
