Week Ending: November 14, 2021

Released: November 15, 2021

According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Arkansas, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the **week ending Sunday, November 14, 2021**. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 16 percent short, 74 percent adequate, and 8 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 20 percent short, 70 percent adequate, and 7 percent surplus. Low temperatures ranged from 35.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Cabot and Murfreesboro to 43.6 degrees Fahrenheit at Winslow. Highs ranged from 59.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Kingston to 75.0 degrees Fahrenheit at Crossett. Light precipitation was received throughout the State, with the highest concentration occurring in the central part of the State with an average of 1.09 inches.
