Winter Wheat Production Down from 2021

Arkansas **winter wheat** production in 2022 totaled 7.95 million bushels, down 5 percent from the 8.41 million bushels in 2021. Acres planted to winter wheat for all purposes in 2022, at 220,000, is up 5 percent from 2021. Harvested area for 2022, at 150,000 acres, is up 5,000 acres from last year. The state average yield for 2022 is estimated at 53 bushels per acre, down 5 bushels from last year.

Oat production in 2022 for Arkansas totaled 366,000 bushels, down 32 percent from the 540,000 bushels in 2021. Acres planted to oats for all purposes in 2022, at 10,000, is unchanged from 2021. Harvested area for 2022, at 6,000 acres, is unchanged from last year. The state average yield for 2022 is estimated at 61 bushels per acre, down 29 bushels from last year.

United States **winter wheat** production totaled 1.10 billion bushels in 2022, down 14 percent from the revised 2021 total of 1.28 billion bushels. Area harvested for grain totaled 23.5 million acres, down 8 percent from the previous year. The United States yield is estimated at 47.0 bushels per acre, down 3.2 bushels from the previous year.


