Arkansas Agricultural Cash Receipts Report
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Cooperating with the University of Arkansas – Division of Agriculture
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Arkansas Ranks 16th in U.S. Agricultural Cash Receipts for 2015

Arkansas cash receipts from all commodities totaled \$8.99 billion for the 2015 calendar year, down \$1.24 billion, or 12 percent below 2014. Arkansas ranked 16th in the nation in total agricultural cash receipts, with 16th in total crop cash receipts, and 12th in total livestock cash receipts. Rice and soybean cash receipts accounted for 73 percent of the total Arkansas crop cash receipts in 2015. Arkansas rice cash receipts in 2015 accounted for 43 percent of the U.S. total rice cash receipts. Broilers accounted for 63 percent of the total livestock cash receipts in 2015 for Arkansas. Cash receipts from livestock and livestock products decreased 9 percent from 2014 to \$5.22 billion.




