

Arkansas Chick Placements Up 3 Percent from Last Year


Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Arkansas were 19.1 million during the week ending May 30, 2015. Placements were up 3 percent from the comparable week in 2014 but down 2 percent from the previous week.

Arkansas hatcheries set 21.7 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending May 30, 2015, up 1 percent from the same period last year and up 2 percent from the previous week.

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 2 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 219 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 30, 2015, up 2 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 210 million eggs in incubators during the week ending May 30, 2015, up 2 percent from the year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 84 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 4 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 180 million chicks for meat production during the week ending May 30, 2015, up 4 percent from a year ago. Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 173 million chicks for meat production during the week ending May 30, 2015, up 4 percent from the year earlier. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 10, 2015 through May 30, 2015 for the United States were 3.70 billion. Cumulative placements were up 3 percent from the same period a year earlier.
