





Arkansas Chick Placements Down 2 Percent from Last Year


Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Arkansas were 18.8 million during the week ending January 9, 2016. Placements were down 2 percent from the comparable week in 2015 and down 1 percent from the previous week.

Arkansas hatcheries set 21.7 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending January 9, 2016, up 2 percent from the same period last year but down slightly from the previous week.

Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Up 1 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 215 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 9, 2016, up 1 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 207 million eggs in incubators during the week ending January 9, 2016, up 1 percent from the year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 84 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Down Slightly

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 176 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 9, 2016, down slightly from a year ago. Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 170 million chicks for meat production during the week ending January 9, 2016, down slightly from the year earlier.
