

## Arkansas Chick Placements Up 17 Percent from Last Year


Broiler-type chicks placed for meat production in Arkansas were 20.7 million during the week ending April 2, 2016. Placements were up 17 percent from the comparable week in 2015 and up 8 percent from the previous week.

Arkansas hatcheries set 22.8 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending April 2, 2016, up 3 percent from the same period last year and up 5 percent from the previous week.

## Broiler-Type Eggs Set in the United States Down 1 Percent

Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 217 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 2, 2016, down 1 percent from a year ago. Hatcheries in the 19 State weekly program set 209 million eggs in incubators during the week ending April 2, 2016, down 1 percent from the year earlier. Average hatchability for chicks hatched during the week in the United States was 84 percent. Average hatchability is calculated by dividing chicks hatched during the week by eggs set three weeks earlier.

## Broiler-Type Chicks Placed in the United States Up 3 Percent

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 179 million chicks for meat production during the week ending April 2, 2016, up 3 percent from a year ago. Broiler growers in the 19 State weekly program placed 173 million chicks for meat production during the week ending April 2, 2016, up 3 percent from the year earlier. Cumulative placements from the week ending January 9, 2016 through April 2, 2016 for the United States were 2.30 billion. Cumulative placements were up 1 percent from the same period a year earlier.
