### Broiler-Type Eggs Set Down 4 Percent From Last Year

Arkansas hatcheries set 23.3 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending December 7, 2019, down 4 percent from the comparable week in 2018 and down 1 percent from the previous week.


Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 233 million eggs in incubators during the week ending December 7, 2019, up 7 percent from a year ago.

### Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Down Slightly


Arkansas broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 22.0 million during the week ending December 7, 2019, down slightly from the comparable week in 2018 but up 3 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 188 million for meat production during the week ending December 7, 2019, up 3 percent from a year ago.
