Broiler-Type Eggs Set Down 3 Percent from Last Year

Arkansas hatcheries set 23.2 million broiler-type eggs during the week ending June 20, 2020, down 3 percent from the comparable week in 2019 and down 1 percent from the previous week.


Hatcheries in the United States weekly program set 235 million eggs in incubators during the week ending June 20, 2020, up 1 percent from a year ago.

Broiler-Type Chicks Placed Down 8 Percent


Arkansas broiler-type chicks placed for meat production were 22.1 million chicks during the week ending June 20, 2020, down 8 percent from the comparable week in 2019 but up 5 percent from the previous week.

Broiler growers in the United States weekly program placed 189 million chicks for meat production during the week ending June 20, 2020, down 1 percent from a year ago.
