Milk Production Down 23 Percent from Previous Quarter

Arkansas milk production during the July - September 2016 quarter was 17 million pounds, down 15 percent from the same period in 2015 and down 23 percent from the April - June 2016 quarter. The average number of milk cows on farms during the quarter was 6,000 head, 1,000 head fewer than the same period last year and down 500 head from the previous quarter.

Milk production in the United States during the July - September quarter totaled 52.6 billion pounds, up 1.7 percent from the July - September quarter last year.

The average number of milk cows in the United States during the quarter was 9.34 million head, 9,000 head more than the April - June quarter, and 21,000 head more than the same period last year.
