### June Egg Production Down 8 Percent from Last Year


Egg production in Arkansas totaled 325 million eggs during June 2022, down 6 percent from the previous month and down 8 percent from June 2021. The number of layers during June 2022 averaged 15.5 million, down 1 percent from the previous month and down 9 percent from this time last year. Egg production per 100 layers averaged 2,099 eggs, down 5 percent from the previous month but up 2 percent from a year ago.

United States egg production totaled 8.67 billion during June 2022, down 3 percent from last year. The average number of layers during June 2022 totaled 366 million, down 4 percent from last year. June egg production per 100 layers was 2,367 eggs, up 2 percent from June 2021.

#### Broiler-Type Chicks Hatched Up 3 Percent

Broiler-type chicks hatched in Arkansas during June 2022 totaled 85.5 million, up 3 percent from June 2021.

Broiler-type chicks hatched in United States during June 2022 totaled 835 million, up 1 percent from June 2021.
