USDA TO MEASURE FINANCIAL HEALTH OF AMERICA'S FARMS

SACRAMENTO, CA, January 12, 2011 – Starting in late January, the U.S. Department of Agriculture's National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) will contact farmers and ranchers across the nation to conduct the Agricultural Resource Management Survey (ARMS). This survey will provide farmers and ranchers with an opportunity to provide accurate, real-world data that will help shape the policies, programs and issues that affect them.

“ARMS asks a small, but representative, sample of farmers about their operations in order to understand the current financial state of U.S. agriculture,” said Vic Tolomeo, director of the NASS California Field Office. “Participation in ARMS is so important because government and agricultural leaders use the information needed to make sound decisions that impact the future of farmers, their families, their businesses and their communities.”

The survey will be conducted from January through mid-April. In an effort to obtain the most accurate data, NASS will reach out to nearly 35,000 producers nationwide, including approximately 2,600 in California. They will be asked to provide data on their operating expenditures, production costs and household characteristics.

“Farm organizations, the U.S. Department of Agriculture, other government agencies, members of Congress, and State and local officials use the collective information from ARMS to answer questions and make important decisions concerning the economic viability of American agriculture, the rural economy and other emerging issues,” explained Tolomeo.

As with all NASS surveys, information provided by respondents is confidential by law. NASS safeguards the confidentiality of all responses, ensuring no individual respondent or operation can be identified.
