U.S. JULY EGG PRODUCTION


U.S. egg production totaled 7.97 billion during July 2013, up 3 percent from last year. Production included 6.88 billion table eggs, and 1.09 billion hatching eggs, of which 1.01 billion were broiler-type and 77 million were egg-type. The total number of layers during July 2013 averaged 344 million, up 2 percent from last year. July egg production per 100 layers was 2,313 eggs, up slightly from July 2012.

All layers in the U.S. on August 1, 2013 totaled 345 million, up 3 percent from last year. The 345 million layers consisted of 289 million layers producing table or market type eggs, 52.6 million layers producing broiler-type hatching eggs, and 3.15 million layers producing egg-type hatching eggs. Rate of lay per day on August 1, 2013, averaged 74.5 eggs per 100 layers, down slightly from August 1, 2012.


CALIFORNIA EGG PRODUCTION

California's egg production during July totaled 461 million, up 21 million from June's production, and up one million from July 2012. The average number of layers during the month totaled 19.0 million, up slightly from last month, but down three percent from July 2012. Eggs per 100 layers during the month were 2,424, compared to 2,321 a month earlier, and 2,352 in July 2012.

U.S. BROILER-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED

Broiler-type chicks hatched during July 2013 totaled 782 million, up 2 percent from July 2012. Eggs in incubators totaled 626 million on August 1, 2013, up 2 percent from a year earlier.


Leading breeders placed 6.57 million broiler-type pullet chicks for future domestic hatchery supply flocks during July 2013, up 8 percent from July 2012.

U.S. EGG-TYPE CHICK HATCH


Egg-type chicks hatched during July 2013 totaled 38.5 million, up 8 percent from July 2012. Eggs in incubators totaled 35.4 million on August 1, 2013, down 8 percent from a year ago.

Domestic placements of egg-type pullet chicks for future hatchery supply flocks by leading breeders totaled 272 thousand during July 2013, up slightly from June 2012.

U.S. TURKEY HATCHERY PRODUCTION

Turkey eggs in incubators on August 1, 2013, in the U.S. totaled 27.7 million, down 4 percent from August 1, 2012. Eggs in incubators were up 1 percent from the July 1, 2013 total of 27.5 million eggs.

The 23.5 million net poult placed during July 2013 in the U.S. were down 11 percent from the number placed during the same month a year earlier. Net placements were up 12 percent from the June 2013 total of 21.0 million.

Turkey poults hatched during July 2013, in the U.S. totaled 23.8 million, down 9 percent from July 2012. Poults hatched were up 13 percent from the June 2013 total of 21.2 million poults.

U.S. POULTRY AND EGG PRICES

Nationally, the July market egg price, at 82.1 cents per dozen, is up 12.7 cents from June, and up 5.7 cents from last year. The July broiler price, at 61.0 cents per pound, is down 5.0 cents from last month, but up 14.0 cents from a year ago. The July turkey price, at 67.9 cents per pound, is up 2.2 cents from June, but down 5.0 cents from a year earlier.


