# Pacific Region Cattle on Feed

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in California for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 570,000 head on June 1, 2022. The inventory was unchanged from last month and 5% above June 1, 2021. During May, placements in feedlots totaled 64,000 head, 9% below the previous year. Net placements were 57,000 head. Marketings of fed cattle during May totaled 57,000 head, 10% below May 2021. Other disappearance totaled 7,000 head during May, unchanged from May 2021.

Cattle and calves on feed for the slaughter market in the United States for feedlots with capacity of 1,000 or more head totaled 11.8 million head on June 1, 2022. The inventory was 1% above June 1, 2021. Placements in feedlots during May totaled 1.87 million head, 2% below 2021. Net placements were 1.79 million head. Marketings of fed cattle during May totaled 1.91 million head, 2% above 2021. Other disappearance totaled 76,000 head during May, 13% above 2021.
