JULY 2011 ERRATA TO THE FINAL GRAPE CRUSH REPORT, 2010 CROP

SACRAMENTO – California's *July 2011 Errata to the Final Grape Crush Report, 2010 Crop* released today. The report contains additional and revised data, which were derived from information received after the March 10, 2011 release of the final crush report. The most significant changes by tonnage were an increase of 462.6 tons for Verdelho and a decrease of 462.6 tons for Vermentino, both in District 11. At the State level, 2010 tons crushed increased by 406.4 tons to 3,986,314.0 tons. The average price per ton paid for grapes increased by \$0.07 per ton to \$545.16.
