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## U.S. JUNE EGG PRODUCTION


U.S. egg production totaled 7.75 billion during June 2013, up 3 percent from last year. Production included 6.68 billion table eggs, and 1.07 billion hatching eggs, of which 993 million were broiler-type and 74.0 million were egg-type. The total number of layers during June 2013 averaged 345 million, up 2 percent from last year. June egg production per 100 layers was 2,249 eggs, up 1 percent from June 2012.

All layers in the U.S. on July 1, 2013 totaled 344 million, up 2 percent from last year. The 344 million layers consisted of 288 million layers producing table or market type eggs, 52.4 million layers producing broiler-type hatching eggs, and 3.10 million layers producing egg-type hatching eggs. Rate of lay per day on July 1, 2013, averaged 74.6 eggs per 100 layers, up 1 percent from July 1, 2012.


## CALIFORNIA EGG PRODUCTION

California's egg production during June totaled 440 million, down 16.0 million from May's production, and down six million from June 2012. The average number of layers during the month totaled 19.0 million, down one percent from last month, and three percent from June 2012. Eggs per 100 layers during the month were 2,321, compared to 2,381 a month earlier, and 2,272 in June 2012.

**U.S. BROILER-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED**

Broiler-type chicks hatched during June 2013 totaled 762 million, up 1 percent from June 2012. Eggs in incubators totaled 629 million on July 1, 2013, up 3 percent from a year earlier.

Leading breeders placed 7.01 million broiler-type pullet chicks for future domestic hatchery supply flocks during June 2013, up 3 percent from June 2012.

**U.S. EGG-TYPE CHICK HATCH**


Egg-type chicks hatched during June 2013 totaled 40.9 million, up 5 percent from June 2012. Eggs in incubators totaled 38.3 million on July 1, 2013, up 5 percent from a year ago.

Domestic placements of egg-type pullet chicks for future hatchery supply flocks by leading breeders totaled 189 thousand during June 2013, up 59 percent from June 2012.



## U.S. POULTRY AND EGG PRICES

Nationally, the June market egg price, at 69.4 cents per dozen, is down 28.2 cents from May, but up 0.5 cents from last year. The June broiler price, at 67.0 cents per pound, is down 1.0 cents from last month, but up 17.0 cents from a year ago. The June turkey price, at 65.8 cents per pound, is up 0.9 cents from May, but down 8.1 cents from a year earlier.



## U.S. TURKEY HATCHERY PRODUCTION

Turkey eggs in incubators on July 1, 2013, in the U.S. totaled 27.0 million, down 9 percent from July 1, 2012. Eggs in incubators were up 2 percent from the June 1, 2013 total of 26.5 million eggs.


Turkey poult hatched during June 2013, in the U.S. totaled 21.2 million, down 15 percent from June 2012. Poults hatched were down 4 percent from the May 2013 total of 22.1 million poults.

The 21.0 million net poults placed during June 2013 in the U.S. were down 16 percent from the number placed during the same month a year earlier. Net placements were down 3 percent from the May 2013 total of 21.7 million.
