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U.S. JANUARY EGG PRODUCTION


U.S. egg production totaled 8.21 billion during January 2014, up 2 percent from last year. Production included 7.13 billion table eggs, and 1.08 billion hatching eggs, of which 997 million were broiler-type and 78 million were egg-type. The total number of layers during January 2014 averaged 351 million, up 2 percent from last year. January egg production per 100 layers was 2,336 eggs, up slightly from January 2013.

CALIFORNIA EGG PRODUCTION

California's egg production during January totaled 398 million, down 16 million from December's production, and down 32 million from January 2013. The average number of layers during the month totaled 16.7 million, down one percent from last month, and down 9 percent from January 2013. Eggs per 100 layers during the month were 2,378, compared to 2,454 a month earlier, and 2,327 in January 2013.


All layers in the U.S. on February 1, 2014 totaled 351 million, up 2 percent from last year. The 351 million layers consisted of 294 million layers producing table or market type eggs, 53.1 million layers producing broiler-type hatching eggs, and 3.23 million layers producing egg-type hatching eggs. Rate of lay per day on February 1, 2014, averaged 74.9 eggs per 100 layers, up slightly from February 1, 2013.

U.S. BROILER-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED

Broiler-type chicks hatched during January 2014 totaled 767 million, up 1 percent from January 2013. Eggs in incubators totaled 624 million on February 1, 2014, up 2 percent from a year earlier.

Leading breeders placed 6.47 million broiler-type pullet chicks for future domestic hatchery supply flocks during January 2014, up 3 percent from January 2013.

U.S. EGG-TYPE CHICKS HATCHED

Egg-type chicks hatched during January 2014 totaled 43.9 million, up 5 percent from January 2013. Eggs in incubators totaled 39.7 million on February 1, 2014, up 3 percent from a year ago.

Domestic placements of egg-type pullet chicks for future hatchery supply flocks by leading breeders totaled 270 thousand during January 2014, down 23 percent from January 2013.

U.S. POULTRY AND EGG PRICES


Nationally, the January market egg price, at 90.6 cents per dozen, is down 30.4 cents from December, and up 4.3 cents from last year. The January broiler price, at 58.0 cents per pound, is up 1.0 cents from last month, but down 3.0 cents from a year ago. The January turkey price, at 64.7 cents per pound, is down 4.0 cents from December, but up 1.8 cents from a year earlier.


**MARKET EGG PRICE, UNITED STATES

U.S. TURKEY HATCHERY PRODUCTION

Turkey eggs in incubators on February 1, 2014, in the U.S. totaled 26.8 million, down 4 percent from February 1, 2013. Eggs in incubators were down 2 percent from the January 1, 2014 total of 27.3 million eggs.

Poults hatched were up 6 percent from the December 2013 total of 22.0 million poults.

Turkey poults hatched during January 2014, in the U.S. totaled 23.4 million, down 3 percent from January 2013.

The 22.4 million net poults placed during January 2014 in the U.S. were down 5 percent from the number placed during the same month a year earlier. Net placements were up 6 percent from the December 2013 total of 21.1 million.
