
Colorado Wheat 2017 Annual Summary

All wheat production in Colorado, estimated at 87.60 million bushels, is down 17 percent from 2016. All wheat yield is 43.2 bushels per acre, down 5.0 bushels per acre from a year ago.


Winter wheat producers seeded 2.25 million acres in the fall of 2016 for harvest in 2017, down from 2.35 million acres seeded for the previous year's crop. Acreage harvested for grain decreased 170,000 acres from last year to 2.02 million acres in 2017. Winter wheat production is estimated at 86.86 million bushels, down 17 percent from last year. Winter wheat yield, at 43.0 bushels per acre, is down 5.0 bushels per acre from last year. Spring wheat seedings, at 10,000 acres, are down 1,000 acres from last year. Acreage harvested totaled 9,000 acres, down from 10,000 acres harvested last year.

Spring wheat production is estimated at 738,000 bushels, down 16 percent from last year. Spring wheat yield, at 82.0 bushels per acre, is down 6.0 bushels per acre from last year.


