

Corn Production

In 2012, Colorado ranked fourteenth in the nation in corn production.

In 2012, production for grain totaled 134.3 million bushels, with an average yield of 133 bushels per acre.

In 2012, corn for grain was produced from 1.01 million harvested acres and silage was cut on 160,000 acres.

In 2012, the total value of grain production was estimated at \$947 million.

In 2012, the average price per bushel was \$7.05

Colorado Corn Records

The record yield was set in 1988 with 160 bushels per acre.

The highest production on record was set in 2010 with 182.7 million bushels.
