COLORADO WINTER WHEAT VARIETIES – 2025 CROP

This report provides the results of the Winter Wheat Seedings by Variety Survey, 2025 Crop, conducted by the National Agricultural Statistics Service, Mountain Regional Field Office, USDA. The survey was funded by the Colorado Wheat Administrative Committee.

Colorado wheat producers seeded an estimated 2.10 million acres to winter wheat in the fall of 2024 for harvest in 2025, unchanged from the 2024 crop. **Langin** was the most popular variety seeded in Colorado, up from second place last year, and planted on 12.9 percent of the acreage for the 2025 crop, compared with 11.6 percent for the 2024 crop. **Byrd** moved up from third place to second place, accounting for 10.7 percent of the acreage. **Avery** moved up from fourth place to third place with 7.9 percent of the acreage. **Amplify SF** moved down from first place to fourth place with 6.7 percent of the acreage. **AP Solid** moved up from eighth place to fifth place with 5.7 percent of the acreage. The top five varieties accounted for 43.9 percent of the acreage seeded. **Snowmass 2.0** moved up from ninth place to sixth place with 4.6 percent of the acreage. **Kivari AX** moved down from sixth place to seventh place with 3.9 percent of the acreage. **Byrd CL Plus** moved down from fifth place to eighth place with 3.8 percent of the acreage. **Canvas** moved up from tenth place to ninth place with 2.7 percent of the acreage. **Crescent AX** completes the top ten with 2.6 percent of the acreage seeded.

Colorado wheat producers reported that 52.6 percent of their seed planted was certified wheat seed. Colorado wheat producers reported that 23.1 percent of their seed planted was treated with fungicide or insecticide. The survey of winter wheat producers in Colorado was not sampled to provide a direct expansion of the seeded acreage by variety or a measure of the sampling error.
