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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 5.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 7th, 2020. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 13 percent short, 46 percent adequate, and 38 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 7 percent short, 53 percent adequate, and 37 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 22 percent short, 60 percent adequate, and 15 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 10 percent short, 58 percent adequate, and 32 percent surplus.
