According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 4.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 18<sup>th</sup>, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 46 percent adequate, and 54 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 0 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 53 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 5.0 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 2 percent short, 57 percent adequate, and 41 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 2 percent short, 50 percent adequate, and 48 percent surplus.
