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According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 20, 2021. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 12 percent short, 77 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 8 percent short, 82 percent adequate, and 9 percent surplus. In Delaware, there were 6.0 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 7 percent short, 91 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 4 percent short, 95 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.
