According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, April 24, 2022. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 32 percent short, 66 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 6 percent short, 93 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 4.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 3 percent short, 68 percent adequate, and 29 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 0 percent very short, 19 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 30 percent surplus.
