According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, June 11, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 68 percent very short, 28 percent short, 4 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 45 percent very short, 48 percent short, 7 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 17 percent very short, 33 percent short, 49 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 12 percent very short, 42 percent short, 46 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
