According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 7 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, November 12, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 8 percent very short, 40 percent short, 51 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 15 percent very short, 37 percent short, 47 percent adequate, and 1 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 6.5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 4 percent very short, 53 percent short, 43 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 3 percent very short, 57 percent short, 40 percent adequate, and 0 percent surplus.
