According to the National Agricultural Statistics Service in Maryland, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork for the week ending Sunday, November 26, 2023. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 11 percent short, 83 percent adequate, and 4 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 9 percent very short, 20 percent short, 69 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.

In Delaware, there were 5 days suitable for fieldwork. Topsoil moisture supplies were 2 percent very short, 10 percent short, 86 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus. Subsoil moisture supplies were 1 percent very short, 65 percent short, 32 percent adequate, and 2 percent surplus.
