Delaware 2014 Annual Milk Production up 3.2 Percent from 2013

The annual production of milk for Delaware during 2014 was 96.7 million pounds, 3.2 percent above 2013 according to Dale Hawks, acting State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Delaware Field Office.

Production per cow in Delaware averaged 20,146 pounds for 2014, 625 pounds above 2013.

The average number of milk cows on farms in Delaware during 2014 was 4,800 head, unchanged from 2013.
