Delaware 2018 Annual Milk Production Down 1.4 Percent from 2017

DOVER, DE - The annual production of milk for Delaware during 2018 was 91.5 million pounds, 1.4 percent below 2017, according to Dale Hawks, State Statistician of the USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service, Delaware Field Office.

Production per cow in Delaware averaged 19,063 pounds for 2018, 503 pounds above 2017.

The average number of milk cows on farms in Delaware during 2018 was 4.8 thousand head, down 200 head from 2017.
