## Delaware Small Grains Summary Report

**Dover, DE** – The U.S Department of Agriculture’s National Agricultural Statistics Service (NASS) estimated winter wheat production in Delaware at 4.02 million bushels, up 12% from the 2019 total of 3.60 million bushels, according to Shareefah Williams, state statistician of the Delaware Field Office. Area harvested for grain totaled 55 thousand acres, up 10% from 2019. The average yield per acre was estimated at 73 bushels per harvested acre, up 1 bushel from the previous year.

Barley production was estimated at 1.26 million bushels, up 13% from the 2019 total of 1.12 million bushels. The average yield, at 84 bushels per acre, was up 4 bushels from the previous year. Area harvested for barley totaled 15 thousand acres, up 7% percent from 2019.
