2019-2020 Hawaii Coffee Acreage Decreased; Price and Value of Production Increased

The final Hawaii utilized coffee production is estimated at 26.9 million pounds (cherry basis) for the 2019-2020 season, a 2 percent increase from the previous season, according to a recent report from USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Bearing acreage totaled 6,900 acres, down 200 acres from the prior season. Average yield increased to 3,952 pounds (cherry basis) from 3,845 pounds per acre last season.

The statewide farm price for coffee averaged \$2.02 per pound (cherry basis), up 6 percent from the previous season's price of \$1.90 per pound. The value of utilized production for coffee is estimated at \$54.3 million (cherry basis) for this season, 8 percent more than last season's \$50.2 million.

Growers reported that the crop bloomed and set well despite pressure from coffee berry borer and lingering effects of volcanic activity.
