2018-2019 Hawaii Coffee Acreage Decreased; Price and Value of Production Increased

The final Hawaii utilized coffee production is estimated at 26.4 million pounds (cherry basis) for the 2018-2019 season, a 7 percent increase from the previous season, according to a recent report from USDA's National Agricultural Statistics Service. Bearing acreage totaled 7,100 acres, down 100 acres from the prior season. Average yield increased to 3,845 pounds (cherry basis) from 3,530 pounds per acre last season.

The statewide farm price for coffee averaged \$1.90 per pound (cherry basis), up 7 percent from the previous season's price of \$1.78 per pound. The value of utilized production for coffee is estimated at \$50.2 million (cherry basis) for this season, 15 percent more than last season's \$43.8 million.

Heavy rains followed by dry periods, potentially caused by vog from the Kilauea Volcano, continued to limit production. Sulfur dioxide from volcanic activity also negatively affected yields in some areas. Coffee berry borer and root-knot nematode problems were also reported.
