
## MARCH FRESH PAPAYA INCREASES

Hawaii fresh papaya utilization is estimated at 2.6 million pounds for March 2009, up 13 percent from February 2009, but down 1 percent from March 2008. Fresh utilization for the first quarter of 2009 totaled 7.0 million pounds down 14 percent from the same period last year.

Total in crop acreage for March is estimated at 2,330, a 14 percent increase from the same month last year. Harvested area totaled 1,470 acres, 3 percent more than March 2008.

In March, orchards experienced sunny periods, trade winds, and showers, constant and heavy at times. The wet conditions interrupted orchard maintenance programs. Growers waited for drier periods to continue with their spraying efforts. The

high soil moisture was conducive to root rot, and an increase in fungal leaf spot incidence was reported. Despite the wet weather conditions, orchards appeared to be in fair to good condition. The newly planted seedlings also benefited from the added moisture.

Papaya growers are expected to receive an estimated 48.0 cents per pound for fresh fruit in March, 4 percent (2.0 cents) less than last month and March a year ago.
