



APRIL FRESH PAPAYA DOWN

Hawaii fresh papaya utilization is estimated at 2.5 million pounds for April 2009, declining 3 percent from March 2009 and 4 percent lower than April 2008. Year-to-date fresh utilization for January to April totaled 9.5 million pounds 12 percent less than the same period last year.

Showery weather prevailed across the State at the beginning of April. However, after mid-month, the temperatures became warmer and days were drier with intermittent hazy conditions. Disease, insect infestation, poor fruit quality, and weed growth were evident in some orchards exposed to higher rainfall in March. The added moisture did however benefit new plantings. More sunny periods later in the month helped crop progress. Drier periods allowed growers to concentrate on field maintenance efforts. Orchards were in fair to good condition in April.



PAPAYA: Fresh Utilization, State of Hawaii, 2008-2009¹

Papaya growers are expected to receive an estimated 45.0 cents per pound for fresh fruit in April, 6 percent (3.0 cents) less than last month and 12 percent (6.0 cents) lower than April a year ago.
