
## 2005 FRESH PAPAYA TRAILS 2004

Monthly Hawaii fresh papaya utilization for 2005 trailed the comparable period in 2004, ending 17 percent lower. December output at 2.1 million pounds was down 7 percent from November 2005 and 29 percent below December 2004.

Total in crop acreage is estimated at 2,290 for December, 4 percent lower than September, but 3 percent higher than December 2004. Harvested area totaled 1,780 acres, 22 percent above September and up 27 percent from December 2004.

Weather for December was mainly dry, affecting flowering and fruit development. December's lower output was a reflection of a dry summer. Large areas are being cleared for replanting in the Puna district of Hawaii island. Growers actively sprayed orchards to keep Papaya Ringspot Virus controlled. Fungal diseases were reduced with drier weather and continued spraying routines. A heavier harvest is expected for January.

## PAPAYA: Fresh Utilization, State of Hawaii, 2004-2005



Papaya growers are expected to receive an estimated 38.0 cents per pound for fresh fruit in December, 6 percent (2.0 cents) more than last month and up 14 percent (4.6 cents) more than December 2004.
