Taro for poi millings off to slow start in 2003

The Hawaii Agricultural Statistics Service estimates poi millers utilized 1.15 million pounds of taro during the first quarter of 2003, down 16 percent from the fourth quarter of 2002 and down 15 percent compared to the first quarter of last year. February's taro for poi output of 370,000 pounds is also the lowest monthly total since June 1997.

It is difficult to pinpoint the exact reason for the decline in taro for poi millings during the first quarter, but it is likely to be a combination of untimely rains, cool temperatures, and continuing problem with pests.
