A Quarterly Report of Taro Milled for Poi

Taro For Poi Millings Remain Steady

The Hawaii Agricultural Statistics Service estimates poi millers utilized 1.5 million pounds of taro during the third quarter of 2001, up 4 percent from the second quarter, but 7 percent lower than the third quarter of last year.

The third quarter of 2001 also saw taro for poi millings reach the highest monthly level of the year so far with 510,000 pounds in August . In general, taro for poi millings have been relatively steady this year. Except for a drop to 440,000 pounds in April, taro for poi millings have been around 500,000 pounds per month.
