Total taro for poi production increased during 2004

The Hawaii Agricultural Statistics estimates poi millers utilized 1.3 million pounds of taro during the fourth quarter of 2004, down 4 percent from the previous quarter and down 10 percent compared to the fourth quarter of 2003.

The final quarter of 2004 began with 420,000 pounds in October, a 5-percent decrease from September. Taro for poi production remained at 420,000 pounds in November before increasing 7 percent to 450,000 pounds in December. For the year, total taro for poi production is estimated at 5.0 million pounds, up 6 percent from 2003.

Taro farmers faced weather conditions were less than ideal for taro farming during the fourth quarter of 2004 as excessive rains and cloudy skies slowed drop development. October marks the start of Hawaii's wet, or rainy, season and that was validated by several episodes of heavy showers during the month. The worst rainstorm

occurred in the evening of October 30th over Manoa Valley on Oahu. Intense showers caused the Manoa Stream to overflow and flood homes and parts of the University of Hawaii's Manoa campus. Losses at the University of Hawaii are expected to total in the millions of dollars. Heavy rains also caused some minor flooding on October 12 (Big Island, Central and East Oahu), October 13 (Oahu, Big Island, and East Maui), October 15 (East Kauai), October 19 (East Big Island), October 24 (East Kauai), October 25 (Oahu), October 27 (North Kauai), and October 31 (Central Oahu). Wet weather continued into November, although not as intense. Flood advisories or flash flood warnings were issued on 10 days during the month. Farmers got a respite from the wet weather in December when trade winds returned and brought drier conditions for most of the month. Showers returned in the closing days of the month.■
