### **All Wheat Stocks Stored in Northwest Region Down 5 Percent from Last Year.**

**All Wheat** stored in all positions on September 1, 2014 totaled 83.1 million bushels in Idaho, up from 76.9 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 5 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 38 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, wheat stored in all positions totaled 41.3 million bushels, up from 37.9 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 1 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 30 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, wheat stored in all positions totaled 120 million bushels, down from 142 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 15 percent, on-farm stocks were also down 15 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, wheat stored in all positions totaled 1.91 billion bushels, up from 1.87 billion bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 9 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 30 percent compared to the previous year.

**Barley** stocks in all positions on September 1, 2014 totaled 41.3 million bushels in Idaho, down from 44.4 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 14 percent, while on-farm stocks were unchanged compared to the previous year. In Oregon, barley stored in all positions totaled 1.48 million bushels, down from 2.50 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 35 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 44 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, barley stored in all positions totaled 6.19 million bushels, down from 10.9 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 48 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 20 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, barley stored in all positions totaled 179 million bushels, down from 196 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 11 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 7 percent compared to the previous year.

**Oats** stored in off-farm locations on September 1, 2014 totaled 177,000 bushels in Idaho, up from 175,000 bushels a year ago. In Oregon, oats stored in off-farm locations totaled 346,000 bushels, down from 462,000 bushels a year ago. In Washington, oats stored in off-farm locations totaled 90,000 bushels, up from 68,000 bushels a year ago. Nationally, oats stored in all positions totaled 73.2 million bushels, up from 63.5 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 24 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 9 percent compared to the previous year.

**Corn** stored in off-farm locations on September 1, 2014, in Idaho and Oregon, were not published to avoid disclosing data from individual operations. In Washington, corn stored in off-farm locations totaled 5.43 million bushels, up from 1.86 million bushels a year ago. Nationally, corn stored in all positions totaled 1.24 billion bushels, up from 821 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 42 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 68 percent compared to the previous year.


