All Wheat Stocks Stored in Northwest Region Down 3 Percent from Last Year

All Wheat stored in all positions on December 1, 2013 totaled 46.8 million bushels in Idaho, down from 50.1 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 7 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 6 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, wheat stored in all positions totaled 31.2 million bushels, down from 37.7 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 18 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 13 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, wheat stored in all positions totaled 109 million bushels, up from 105 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 3 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 10 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, wheat stored in all positions totaled 1.46 billion bushels, down from 1.67 billion bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 16 percent, while on-farm stocks were down slightly compared to the previous year.

Barley stocks in all positions on December 1, 2013 totaled 37.6 million bushels in Idaho, up from 34.8 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 4 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 24 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, barley stored in all positions totaled 1.74 million bushels, up from 1.04 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 116 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 35 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, barley stored in all positions totaled 10.4 million bushels, up from 8.10 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 26 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 44 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, barley stored in all positions totaled 170 million bushels, up from 158 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 3 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 12 percent compared to the previous year.

Oats stored in off-farm locations on December 1, 2013 totaled 153,000 bushels in Idaho, down from 207,000 bushels a year ago. In Oregon, oats stored in off-farm locations totaled 413,000 bushels, up from 287,000 bushels a year ago. Nationally, oats stored in all positions totaled 48.0 million bushels, down from 73.2 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 52 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 2 percent compared to the previous year.

Corn stored in off-farm locations on December 1, 2013 totaled 6.61 million bushels in Idaho, down from 9.67 million bushels a year ago. In Oregon, corn stored in off-farm locations totaled 788,000 bushels, up from 569,000 bushels a year ago. In Washington, corn stored in off-farm locations totaled 16.1 million bushels, up from 9.53 million bushels a year ago. Nationally, corn stored in all positions totaled 10.4 billion bushels, up from 8.03 billion bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 17 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 39 percent compared to the previous year.

Hay stocks on farms on December 1, 2013 totaled 2.35 million tons in Idaho, up 12 percent from a year ago. On-farm hay stocks in Oregon totaled 1.70 million tons, unchanged from 2012. Washington on-farm hay stocks totaled 1.20 million tons, unchanged from last year. Hay stocks stored on all farms at the US level totaled 89.3 million tons, up 17 percent from 2012.
