All Wheat Stocks Stored in Northwest Region Down 1 Percent from December 1, 2022

All wheat stored in all positions on December 1, 2023 totaled 60.1 million bushels in Idaho, up from 58.4 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 6 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 2 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, wheat stored in all positions totaled 27.2 million bushels, down from 33.9 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 26 percent, while on-farm stocks were up 13 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, wheat stored in all positions totaled 123 million bushels, up from 120 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 9 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 43 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, wheat stored in all positions totaled 1.41 billion bushels, up from 1.31 billion bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 7 percent, and on-farm stocks were up 9 percent compared to the previous year.

Barley stocks in all positions on December 1, 2023 totaled 32.5 million bushels in Idaho, down from 37.3 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 8 percent, and on-farm stocks were down 17 percent compared to the previous year. In Oregon, barley stored in all positions totaled 762,000 bushels, down from 1.34 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were down 31 percent, and on-farm stocks were down 65 percent compared to the previous year. In Washington, barley stored in all positions totaled 4.73 million bushels, down from 5.03 million a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 1 percent bushels, while on-farm stocks were down 24 percent compared to the previous year. Nationally, barley stored in all positions totaled 142 million bushels, up from 138 million bushels from a year ago. Off-farm stocks were up 9 percent, while on-farm stocks were down 1 percent compared to the previous year.

Oats stored in off-farm locations on December 1, 2023 totaled 107,000 bushels in Idaho, down 65 percent from a year ago. In Oregon, oats stored in off-farm locations totaled 305,000 bushels, down 7 percent from a year ago. In Washington, oats stored in off-farm locations totaled 73,000 bushels, up from 67,000 bushels a year ago. Nationally, oats stored in all positions totaled 62.6 million bushels, up from 53.7 million bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were 38.5 million bushels, up 31 percent from the previous year, while on-farm stocks were 24 million bushels, down 1 percent compared to the previous year.

Corn stored in off-farm locations on December 1, 2023 totaled 6.99 million bushels in Idaho, up 29 percent from a year ago. In Oregon, corn stored in off-farm locations totaled 2.19 million bushels, up 235 percent from a year ago. In Washington, corn stored in off-farm locations totaled 7.61 million bushels, down 15 percent from a year ago. Nationally, corn stored in all positions totaled 12.2 billion bushels, up from 10.8 billion bushels a year ago. Off-farm stocks were 4.34 billion bushels, up 7 percent from the previous year, and on-farm stocks were 7.83 billion bushels, up 16 percent compared to the previous year.


