

HOGS AND PIGS

Illinois hog producers had 4.65 million hogs and pigs on hand December 1, 2011, up 6 percent from a year earlier. The inventory consisted of 480,000 head of breeding stock and 4,170,000 market hogs. In 2011, Illinois produced 1.90 billion pounds of live hogs, fourth in the United States.

Farrowings for the period December 2010 through November 2011 totaled 1.025 million, down 25 thousand from a year earlier. The average number of pigs saved per litter was 9.84, up from 9.51 the previous year.

The December 2010 through November 2011 pig crop was 9.99 million, nearly the same as last year. Hog and pig marketings in 2011 totaled 11.58 million head, up 1 percent from 2010.
