



Illinois Cattle


Released January 30, 2015

All cattle and calves as of January 1, 2015 totaled 1.14 million head, 1 percent above January 1, 2014. All cows and heifers that have calved, at 470,000 head, were up 4 percent from January 1, 2014. The 2014 calf crop was estimated at 410,000 head, up 6 percent from 2013.
